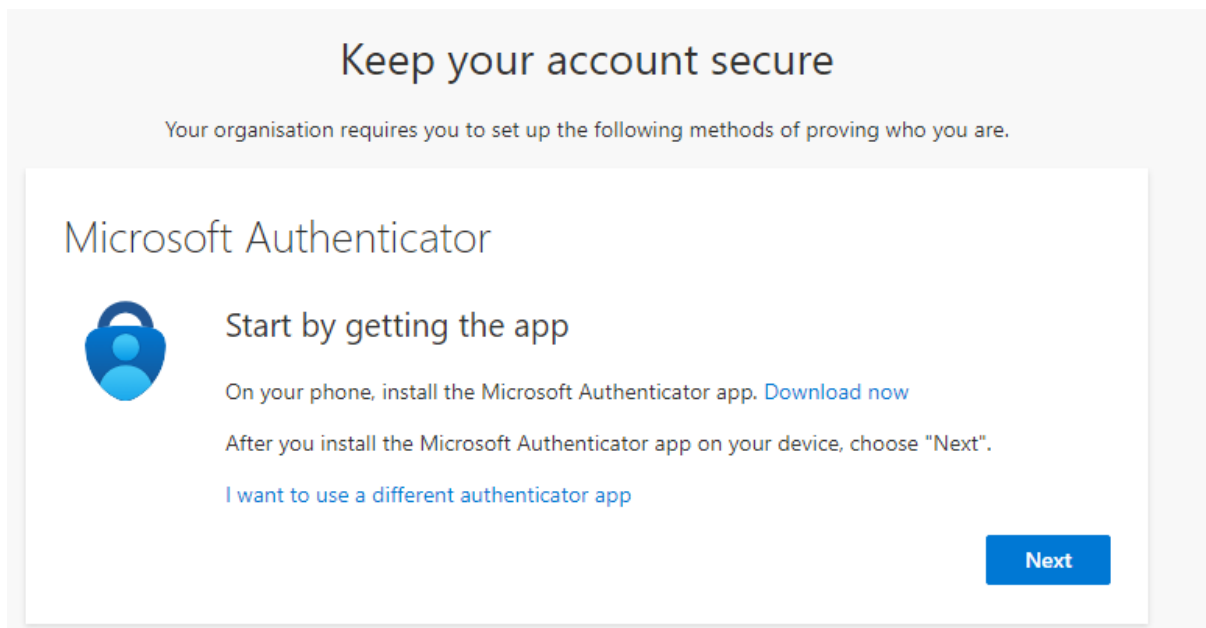
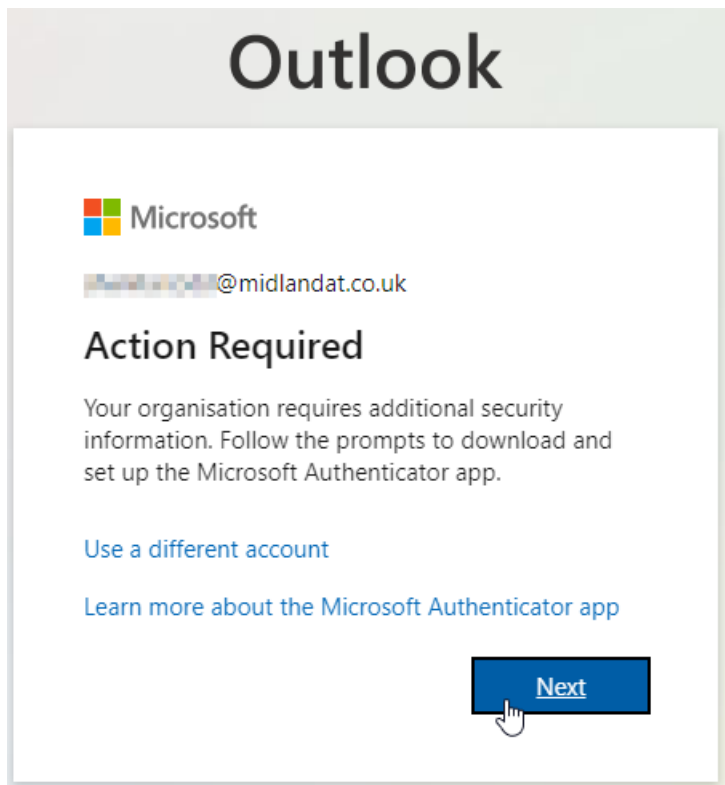


Setting up Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

Where we can we've imported existing MFA information from the college system (e.g the Grey code tokens) However, upon initial login you may be **prompted to setup MFA**. Currently the only option is **Microsoft Authenticator**, this is a **free app available on both Android and iOS (Apple) devices**.

Once initially logging it, it will prompt you to enter details, simply follow the wizard. It usually consists of scanning the QR code on the computer, you would then receive a pop up on your phone to enter the number displayed on the screen

If prompted, allow notifications. Then add an account, and select "Work or school".
