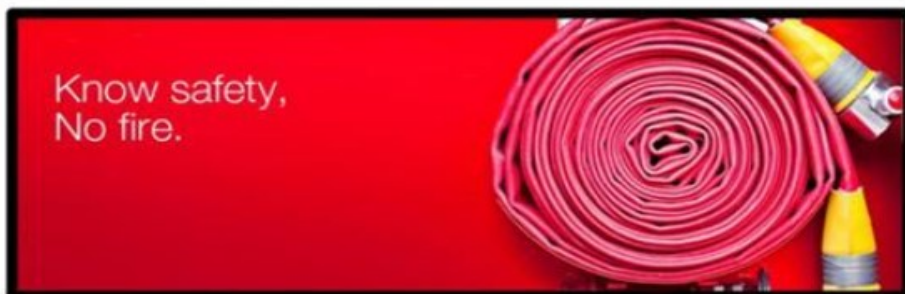




Warwickshire Fire Education Service

UK Maths Challenge Club after school every Friday in HG3

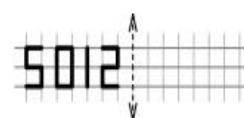
