## Year 10 Drama and Workshops - Loudmouth

On Tuesday 8th November Year 10 participated in a drama presentation and workshops with Loudmouth, a drama PSHE organisation based in Birmingham. The theme was Calling it Out. Calling It Out reinforces to students the vital message of non-tolerance of harmful sexual behaviour.

The performance and discussion-based workshop explore where these behaviours are coming from and alternative positive behaviours. The programme raises the groups' awareness of the huge impacts these everyday incidences of sexual harassment and assault can have on girls and young women and how we all have a role in safely challenging and reporting these behaviours.
