Dear Parents/Carers

We are almost at the end of the first full Autumn Term in our new home. It has been a very busy term and we've not slowed down this week with the Space Centre Trip, History Guest Speaker, Science Christmas Lectures at Birmingham University, Christmas Dinners and the Christmas Show.

As always we are very proud of the Heart, Ambition, Respect and Tenacity our pupils have demonstrated this term. This has been an excellent term for Hartshill Academy with a significant increase in the number of pupils in school every day. We know that on average pupils with attendance below 95% achieve lower grades than their peers with higher attendance. It is important that pupils are in school every day to ensure they do not have gaps in their learning. We are pleased to see more pupils in school each day ensuring they stay on track to make great progress with their learning.

In addition to this the Autumn Term has seen a significant decrease in the number of lates to lessons, lesson removals and suspensions from school. Pupils are clear on the expectations at school and the vast majority are doing the right thing every day to ensure they are learning and aiming to keep getting better everyday.

This term has also seen the formation of our new Pupil Leadership Team. These are our pupils who have put themselves forward for new roles to lead and shape the future for our Hartshill Academy community. We are very proud of all the pupils who have chosen to challenge themselves and develop in this way. There is a new surprise coming in the Spring Term when the pupils return to school too.

A key focus for pupils during HART Time this term has been thinking about what it means to be a person with good character. Throughout this academic year, we will continue our efforts to develop the personal character of our young people. We value an education in which development of character is as important as exam success. We have a clear pathway to promote leadership, working independently and in teams, resilience, integrity, selfdiscipline, compassion, courage and respect for self and others. We want pupils to look back on their academic career at Hartshill Academy as a time of enjoyment and happiness which has inspired and challenged them in equal measure and prepared them for the ups and downs of life.
