Every participant should provide their own white t-shirts. As the powders contain food colouring, we advise all participants to wear old clothing and suitable trainers, considering the potential for clothing stains.

Pupils are allowed to attend school in House colours for their house only that they wish to run in, the changing rooms are open at lunchtime for all pupils to change if they require.

Following the run/walk, an area will be provided to help shake off loose powder. However, we can not allow re-entry into the building to change or use the toilets once participants have taken part in the colour run so pupils need to consider how they are getting home once covered in paint! Many participants choose to wear goggles or old sunglasses to protect their eyes during the run. Additionally, we suggest the use of bin bags or old towels to protect car seats for those commuting from the event.

The colour powder used in this event is certified as non-toxic and non-irritant to the skin. While participants should be mindful of potential contact with the powder on the skin and eyes, the risk of inhalation is minimal. All participants take part at their own risk.
