End of Year Assessment Report 2023-24

Please find in Weduc documents an assessment report for your child, which outlines their achievements in summer assessments

The report shows the following (these are correct at the time of printing):

- Attendance and Punctuality
- Reward and Demerit points
- Reading Stanine
 - The reading stanine shows how a pupils is performing in reading,
 - **Grade 1 shows a pupil is below the expected standard**
 - Additional intervention on phonics is required, pupils may be withdrawn for additional support.
 - Pupils should continue to complete their weekly SPARX reader homework.
 - **Grades 2-3 shows a pupil is below the expected standard**
 - Additional intervention is required, pupils may be withdrawn for additional support.
 - Pupils should continue to complete their weekly SPARX reader homework.
 - **Grades 4-6 shows a pupil is working at the expected standard**
 - Pupils should continue to complete their weekly SPARX reader homework to continue to improve their reading and comprehension.
 - **Grades 7-9 shows a pupil is working above the expected standard**
 - Pupils are reading above their age, they should aim to achieve a Gold reader pass on SPARX reader, allowing them to read any book of their choosing.
- Academic Progress
 - Assessment Percentage, this shows what the pupils have achieved in their summer assessments. Assessments covered all learning completed so far, pupils should be aiming to achieve as close as possible to 100% in every subject
 - Pupils subject ranking for key subjects. This shows where the pupils results are compared to the rest of the year group

In September we will send you an updated report. This will contain comparative rankings and grades to allow you to compare progress with all pupils in the same year group nationally within United Learning.

At Hartshill Academy we work hard every day to develop our HART values. We are very proud of how our pupils have adjusted to all the changes over the last year and how they have applied themselves to their work. We celebrate pupils who demonstrate heart, ambition, respect and tenacity every day.

You can see up to the minute information on rewards awarded to your child by downloading the ClassCharts App. Updated information on demerits can also be found on the ClassCharts App.

For each subject your child's attitude in lessons is recorded as the ratio of positive to negative points given by the class teacher. For example, if 95 positive points have been awarded, and 5 demerit points have been awarded then the ratio would be 95%. We expect all pupils to have a ratio above 95%, this is considered good effort, a ratio of 100% would mean no demerit points have been awarded and the pupil has excellent effort in that subject.
